Explain

- Describe the Events/situation that led to this problem.
- How do we know this is a problem worth solving?

Effects

- What is the impact of this problem on communities?
- What will happen if nothing happens to address this situation?

Who

- List the people and organisations who are involved in tackling this problem already?

(continued)

Causes

- What are the fundamental issues that must be addressed?
- Are there other problems need to be solved at the same time?

Target

- What does success look like?
- how will you know when you have succeeded?

Next

- What are the priorities and what existing issues need to be dealt with first?
